#### Article 20 – Provision of information to employers and the self-employed from outside undertakings

The responsible person must ensure that the employer of any employee(s) from an outside undertaking who is working in or on his premises is provided with comprehensible and relevant information on –

- The risks to that employee
- The preventative and protective measures taken by the responsible person

The responsible person must also ensure that any person working in his undertaking who is not his employee is provided with appropriate instructions and comprehensible and relevant information regarding any risks that he might face.

The responsible person must ensure that employers and their employees described above are –

- Provided with sufficient information to enable them to identify the persons appointed by the responsible person to implement evacuation procedures
