Article 21 – Training

The responsible person must ensure that his employees are provided with adequate and appropriate safety training -

- At the time they are first employed
- On their being exposed to new or increased risks. These might be caused by being transferred or given a change of responsibility, the introduction of new equipment or technology or an introduction of a new work system.

The training must –

- Include suitable and sufficient instruction and training on the appropriate precautions and actions to be taken by the employee
- Be repeated periodically where appropriate
- Be adapted to take account of any new or changed risks
- Be provided in a manner appropriate to the risk identified by the risk assessment
- Take place during working hours
