ANTI-FREEZE IN WATER & FOAM EXTINGUISHERS

It is recommended that manufacturers recommendations and guidance are followed in full in every instance where anti-freeze is used in extinguishers.

The life span of different anti-freeze additives may vary and may necessitate more frequent recharge periods than the standard 5 year maximum prescribed for most extinguishers.

Extinguisher fire ratings may also be altered or voided by addition of anti-freeze.
