CSCS Cards

New members especially may not be aware of the following which applies across the UK:-

With regards to fire protection equipment technicians e.g. extinguishers entering and/or working on a designated building site I understand that everybody requires a CSCS card – specifically a white one with the words ‘construction related occupation’ across the bottom (or equivalent – see below for fire alarms).
